

Wean-Finish Site Manager

Objective

Perform functions associated with all aspects of live animal movements including weaned pig movements, market hog movements, between site movements and gilt movements.

Provide daily care to all animals at sites.

Production Responsibilities

- Coordinate with site supervisor to meet specified goals and deadlines.
- Ensure fresh feed is available for all animals.
- Ensure adequate water flow is available for all animals.
- Maintain correct environment for all animals.
- Perform and assist with repairs and maintenance of facility and equipment.
- Daily care of all animals including vaccinations, sorting, etc.

Facility Responsibilities

- Maintain proper bio-security at all sites.
- Ensure safe and neat work environment for all personnel.

Administrative Responsibilities

- Submit weights, head numbers, etc. in a timely manner.
- Submit production reports on expected schedule.

Required Skills

- Knowledge of swine physiology and factors affecting health and efficiencies.
- Knowledge of and ability to work with automated feeding systems.

- Knowledge of environmental requirements of weanling pigs to market hogs.
- Ability to work with others to build high morale, creative positive energy, and group commitments to goals and objectives.
- Self-motivated and able to organize and prioritize tasks.
- Ability to effectively communicate orally and in writing with other employees and company contacts.
- Respect and care for all animals and personnel.
- Work with site supervisor to standardize production routines to work safely and productively.
- Ability to work independently and initiate responses in a timely manner.
- Must understand pig flow at all levels.

Experience

- Prior experience in swine unit desired.

Physical Requirements

- Standing, walking and ability to be on feet 8-10 hours per day
- Frequent bending, reaching, squatting and kneeling
- Frequent lifting of objects
- Occasional lifting objects weighing over 50 pounds
